

## Useful gawk one-liners

1. print every input line in which the last line is more than 4
2. print the total number of fields in all input lines
3. print the total number of lines that contain Beth
4. print the largest first field and the line that contains it (assume \$1 is positive)
5. print every line that has at least one field
6. print every line longer than 80 characters
7. print the number of fields in every line followed by the line itself
8. print the first two fields of each line in opposite order
9. exchange the first two fields of every line then print the line
10. print every line with the first field replaced by the line number
11. print every line after erasing the second field
12. print in reverse order the fields in every line
13. print the sums of the fields in every line
14. add all fields in all lines and print the sum
15. print every line after replacing each field with its absolute value
